
How to find us



By car - Less than one mile west of Ascot and approximately three miles east of Bracknell Town Centre. On the A332, at the mini-roundabout turn on to Brook Ave and follow the road all the way down the hill. The patient car park is on your right.

By bus - You can catch a number of bus services including the X30 from Frimley, 01 from Windsor and X94 from Bracknell.

By train - Ascot train station is only a 15 minute walk away.

A quick, painless procedure - Carried out under local anaesthetic, patients will be in hospital for only two hours between admission and discharge

Referral

Following an appointment with an optician, a referral will be sent with the aim to have an appointment booked within a week.

Assessment

This is a one stop appointment with one of our ophthalmic nurses before immediately seeing an ophthalmologist to discuss the results, and list for surgery if required.

Booking

Once listed for surgery the bookings team will give a date for surgery, which will usually be within four weeks.

Surgery

On the day of surgery, patients will be admitted to individual rooms in the day surgery unit at Heatherwood Hospital. The nursing team will guide them through the next steps. Patients will be in hospital for 90 minutes to two hours.

Post-Op

In most cases its takes four weeks to fully heal. A phone call 10-14 days after surgery will be arranged, followed by a recommendation to see an optician 4-6 weeks after surgery.
