

## Glaucoma Repeat Readings Service (GRRS)

### Frimley ICB

#### Overview

To reduce false positive referrals into HES glaucoma clinics, primary care optometrists can perform repeat readings of IOP to confirm that they are consistently outside normal limits.

#### Service Information

##### Patient eligibility

- Patients of 18 and over registered with a GP in Frimley ICB
- Patients who are identified as having IOP  $\geq 24$ mmHg but  $< 32$ mmHg by NCT (non-contact tonometry), and no other signs of glaucoma.

##### Source of Referral/Signposting to Service

- Via a GOS or private sight test.

##### Service Delivery

- Up to two repeat readings of IOP using a contact application tonometer (Goldmann or Perkins).
- NB the Frimley ICB service pathway **does not** allow for repeat visual fields

##### Service Outcomes

- Discharge to routine follow up or referral to secondary care glaucoma clinic

##### Accreditation

- WOPEC Glaucoma Level 1

##### Practice tariff

- £15 for first repeat contact tonometry
- £15 for second repeat contact tonometry (where indicated)
