Post-Operative Cataract Care – (follow up care after surgery)

Recent changes to post-operative cataract care will allow patients, who have undergone cataract surgery without any complications, to be given their follow up care closer to home.

You have been identified as a patient who would be suitable to have your follow up appointments carried out by a local optician.

What does this mean?

This means that instead of having to return to hospital out-patients for your post-operative appointments you will be able to see a local optician.

You will still receive the same level of care and undergo the same tests as you would in hospital.

You will be able to choose from a list of accredited opticians.

This does not affect your usual sight test and you should continue to attend your chosen opticians for all future sight tests.

What do I need to do?

A list of accredited opticians is on the reverse of this leaflet for you to choose from.

Simply let the hospital staff know which of the local opticians you would like to attend for your post-operative assessment appointment.

The optician will then contact you to arrange an appointment which will take place 4 weeks after surgery.

If you notice any changes in your sight before your review appointment is due, please contact the hospital where you had your surgery for advice.
