

NHSMail (nhs.net account)



NHSMail is a secure email service approved by the Department for Health and Social Care that can be used to safely exchange confidential patient identifiable and sensitive information, enabling better collaboration across organisations







Benefits of NHSMail



Utilising NHSMail to contact health and social care colleagues will reduce the time spent emailing off other platforms or the need to send letters and faxes

- Please note that a NHSMail account must be accessed at least once every 30 days to remain active

I'm a locum, how do I get NHS Mail?

NHSmail accounts can be requested on your behalf by the optometry site you work from the most frequently. Requests should be sent, by the shared mailbox owner to helpdesk@nhs.net from the site's shared mailbox. Optometry user accounts can be linked to a shared mailbox for access, but it is not essential. https://support.nhs.net/knowledge-base/registering-locum-optometrists/

Do I need to complete the Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT) to get NHS Mail

To access NHS Mail, health and care organisations are required to have a <u>Data Security</u> and <u>Protection Toolkit (DSPT)</u> rating of 'Standards Met' or 'Standards Exceeded'.
