

# Eyecare electronic Referral System (EeRS) Update

## All Black Country Hospitals are now fully Live

Wolverhampton and Sandwell (BMEC) hospitals have joined Russells Hall and Walsall hospitals as fully live on the Cinapis EeRS platform.

Over the next few weeks practices will start to see increased referral options appearing on their Cinapis systems, with eventually the choice of any of the Black Country Hospitals for a patient referral.

All practices should use Cinapis EeRS as their first choice for Eyecare referrals.

Each Hospital has its own menu of services, so please ensure you familiarise yourself with the options and any local protocols.

### BMEC Emergency Eye Clinic via EeRS

BMEC now has an Emergency Referrals option on Cinapis that should be the first-choice option for referring any true Ophthalmic Emergency Condition. Information submitted goes directly to the Emergency Department and the patient is sent directly to the BMEC Emergency Department immediately. Phone calls are only required if outside working hours.

This is not yet operational for Dudley or Wolverhampton Emergency Departments.
