


### Patient Summary

**Fundus Image**  
To magnify the image press and hold the right mouse button and drag away from you. Hold down the middle scroll wheel to move the image.



**OCT Image**  
Please include a minimum of 3 OCT images at 3 different points across the OCT feature in question. To magnify the image press and hold the right mouse button and drag away from you. Hold down the middle scroll wheel to move the image.
