What is COTATS?

The Community Optometrist Triage Assessment & Treatment Service (COTATS) is an NHS specialised eye care service offered by accredited Optometrists in the community.

These appointments aim to:

- Diagnose and treat a range of eye conditions,
- Promote eye health,
- o Allow early detection of eye problems,

The service provides personalized care and guidance and deflects patients from the Hospital Eye Services. Post COVID-19 hospital eye services are seeing a large increase in waiting times making this service more essential than ever.

Conditions We Address:

- o Anterior Eye Conditions such as Blepharitis
- o Corneal Conditions such as abrasions/recurrent erosions
- o Differential Diagnosis of Red Eye
- o Dry Eyes/ Epiphora
- o Epiretinal Membrane
- o Field Defects
- o Floaters/ Flashing Lights
- o High IOP
- o Ingrown Eyelashes
- o Loss of Vision/ Blurred Vision
- o Low Vision
- o Naevus
- o Non-Urgent ARMD
- o Ocular Pain
- o Optic Disc Anomalies
- o Pinguecula/ Pterygium
- o Reduced Vision
- o Retinal Lesions
- o Suspect Corneal Dystrophy
- o Suspect Glaucoma

Optometrists accredited and approved by the NHS Lincolnshire ICB.

GOS18 referral to EACH following your standard pathway.

Statistics 2022-2023

COTATS Triaged – 7042 Referrals Referrals dealt with in community – 3049 Result: 54% deflected from Hospital Eye Services.

Why use Community Optometrists?

Efficiency: Patients can access appointments in a shorter time frame at their convenience. This makes it easier for patients to schedule appointments and receive timely care.

Accessibility: Community Optometrists are often more accessible, with multiple locations.

Collaboration: Close collaboration with local hospitals, community surgical schemes and medical professionals ensures seamless care coordination. If a patient requires specialised treatment or surgery, appropriate referrals are made.
