



# TELESCOPE

## Participant Journey

The TELESCOPE study is a Genetic Screening study that will help us see if you have rare variations in specific genes and qualify to join other research studies.

This tool is to help you better understand what to expect during the TELESCOPE study.



## 1. Review & sign genotype consent

To take part in the TELESCOPE study, you must first sign a consent form that will allow the study team to perform genetic testing on your saliva sample.



## 2. Provide Saliva Sample

After you sign the genotype consent, you will be required to give a saliva sample with the provided kit and instructions. The sample will be tested to see if you have the specific gene of interest.



## 3. Genetic testing results released

The results of your genetic test will be provided to your researcher



## 4a. Possibly participate in future studies

### Specific gene variation is NOT identified

If you do not have the specific gene variation, you will be added to a confidential register and contacted for possible participation in future research studies.



## 4b. Be invited to take part in other studies

### Specific gene variation IS identified

If you have the specific rare variant gene of interest, you may be referred to an approved investigational site for potential participation in a separate interventional study.
