Wakefield Area referral guide

If the condition is Acute/Urgent in nature and there is a serious risk of sight loss then refer the patient to Mid Yorkshire Hospital Acute Clinic. Details are in the red box below.

If the condition is non-Urgent then refer the patient to the Mid Yorkshire Hospital Routine Clinic or to one of the five Community Based Clinics in our area. This can be done using EyeV or directly using details below.

Urgent referrals should not be made via EYEV but all other referrals can be.

Cataract referrals should be made via Single Point of Access (SPoA)

Make sure all referrals are accurate and comprehensive and include all relevant information.
